FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

Fiscal year 2021 – 2022 was a year of growth for BAM. As we entered the fourth year of the Sector Council funding and COVID restrictions were lifted, we continued to increase our programming and events both virtually and in-person for our members.

Financial Key highlights for the year:

Total revenue for fiscal year, April 2021 – March 2022 was \$1,220,000 consisting of \$533,400 from the Province of Manitoba Economic Development, Investment and Trade and Manitoba Agriculture. A further \$297,300 was received from development programs, \$214,000 from training and event revenue, \$105,000 in membership revenue and a further \$62,000 in sponsorships.

Total expenses for the year were \$1,165,000 with the largest expense being the delivery of our training and event programs relating directly to our government funding of \$512,000, salary and benefits were the next largest expense of \$496,000 with office administration and overhead at \$155,000 including rent, advertising, and promotion of the bioscience sector in Manitoba.

As of March 31, 2022, Bioscience Association Manitoba had net assets of \$523,400.

In accordance with BAMs' Financial policy, the annual audit was conducted by BDO Canada LLP, an independent auditor and performed in accordance with the Canadian generally accepted auditing standards.

We would like to thank our funders, partners, and members for making the past fiscal year so successful and look forward to your continued participation in our events and programs.






